We ask for your cooperation to ensure a safe and smoothly operated marathon.

Drivers on roads near the course may be requested to stop for extended periods while traffic signals are adjusted before and after the traffic regulations.

Please refrain from driving on the day of the marathon. Detours should be used only if driving is absolutely necessary.

Neither cyclists nor pedestrians are allowed to cross the course. Pedestrians are advised to use footbridges or subway underpasses.

The Civil Aeronautics Act prohibits the use of drones and other unmanned radio-operated flying objects at places where many people gather, such as at start/finish areas and roadsides along the marathon course. To ensure safe and smooth operations, your baggage may be inspected at start/finish areas, etc. Your cooperation is appreciated.
