

Drivers on roads near the course may be requested to stop for extended periods while traffic signals are adjusted before and after the traffic regulations. Please refrain from driving on the day of the marathon. Detours should be used only if driving is absolutely necessary.

Neither cyclists nor pedestrians are allowed to cross the course. Pedestrians are advised to use footbridges or subway underpasses.
